



Grantham Then

Grantham in the Twenties

It is an honour, albeit tinged with sadness, to be invited to take over this column which, since the inception of Grantham Now, has been compiled by the late Malcolm Knapp. I had known Malcolm for over fifty years from when I first attended the Grantham Local History Society of which

he was Chairman, Malcolm's talent for researching aspects of Grantham's past and coming up with diverse and well-chosen images will be a tough act to follow.

Last year marked the centenary of the end of the First World War. Over 300 Grantham men did not return alive and are commemorated in the memorial inside St. Wulfram's Church on the north wall. The monument in the churchyard, designed by Sir Charles Nicholson, has been the focus of the town's annual Remembrance Sunday service since 1921. Borough councillors and townspeople felt that, additionally, there should be another memorial in the community and that of course was Wyndham Park. The Honourable Reggie Wyndham was the third son of the Second Baron Leconfield of Petworth House in Sussex. Reggie was a veteran of the Boer War and subsequently visited Africa and North America hunting and shooting large animals. His winters from 1908 until 1914 were spent in Grantham, where he hunted with the Belvoir Hunt in common with many gentry and professionals in Edwardian society. The hunting season provided employment for saddlers, bridle makers, blacksmiths, grooms and domestic servants in the hunting-boxes and hotels in Grantham that were utilised by those attending the Hunt.

Within days of the outbreak of war, Reggie was appointed in September 1914 as Captain of the Lincolnshire Yeomanry.





This voluntary battalion was then despatched to the western front in September. Before leaving, Wyndham gave £100 towards the relief of distress amongst men who had been laid off at Richard Hornsby & Sons Ltd as the demand for agricultural implements fell away and it had not yet been determined what Hornsby's would be producing for the war effort. Wyndham also put his stable of hunters at the disposal of the military.

On 6 November, just eight weeks after his division had been transported across the Channel, the Hon W R Wyndham was killed in Belgium. He was buried at the small military cemetery in the churchyard at Zillebecke. In December 1919, his grieving mother offered Grantham Borough Council £1000 towards the provision of a Recreation Ground in Grantham. Work on Wyndham Park began in 1922 and the grand opening was held in July 1924 attended by Lady Leconfield. The Heritage Lottery-funded project completed last year has brought new life and facilities to a much-loved jewel in Grantham's townscape.

Unsurprisingly, the provision of facilities at the northeast end of the town prompted clamour for a Recreation Ground at its southern end. Built between March and July 1926, the Houghton Road Recreation ground was renamed in August 1926 as Dysart Park, at the Council's suggestion. Lord Dysart was apparently 'very diffident' about this, lest it be thought he had stipulated this with a view to 'self-advertisement'. This new park contained tennis courts, a bowling green, football pitch and swimming baths. In four weeks during July 1926, 11,840 attendances were recorded at the Dysart Park baths compared with 10,469 at Wyndham Park.

1926 also saw the opening of the new Public Library and Museum on St Peter's Hill funded with help from the Carnegie United Kingdom Trust. With new Council houses, first in Dysart Road and Earlsfield and then in Harrowby Close and Turnor Crescent, Grantham borough should be credited for actions that made the town a 'land fit for Heroes to Live in' as tasked by Prime Minister Lloyd George in 1918.

When you pray for a miracle

Walking upright is quite a feat for us humans when you stop to think about it; nevertheless we just take it for granted, don't we? In point of fact it's surprising that we don't fall over more often. Low Cost Parking for all Commuters

Finding a parking space in Grantham isn't the easiest thing in the world these days. If you're a regular commuter and you use the train a lot in your working or social life you'll know all too well how hard it is to get parked up and how costly it is too. It might come as a surprise therefore to learn that just over two minutes' walk from Grantham's Railway Station there's a safe and secure 24-hour-access pay and display car park standing by to save you not just lots of hassle but lots of money too.

The car park owners offer a totally personalised service as well. Long term parking for multiple consecutive days can be paid for in advance: particularly suitable for business people or holiday-makers going away for several days at a time. At incredibly competitive rates it has to be said too (just £5.00 per weekday and only £2.00 per day at weekends). For shorter stays of up to 5 hours, the rate is only 85p per hour, and, just three minutes from the town centre it's a car park worthy of serious consideration.

Even more convenient, especially for the regular daily commuter, there is the personalised reserved parking option, giving you your own allocated space bearing your car's registration number. This has proven very popular with commuters; even so there are still a few spaces available on a first-

come-first-served basis and can be paid monthly by Bank
Transfer/Standing Order (no contract required – contact for more details). Flexibility can also be arranged for absence during holiday/Christmas periods.
Comparing the costs to those of the railway station's car park it's not unreasonable to state that if you're a regular user you could save yourself somewhere in the region of £1,500 per year.

In any case, during the day there's usually a member of the management in attendance making this a very safe and secure car park indeed. 

Focus on...

Avenue Veterinary Centre

by Richard Huddart, a veterinary surgeon at the Avenue Veterinary Centre in Grantham and Bottesford.

As the New Year kicks in and we prepare for another Spring - the season of lambing and calving on the farms, Richard Huddart reflects on some of the strange (and sometimes disturbing!) cases which have cropped up at the Avenue Veterinary Centre over recent weeks

Although the practice is still heavily involved in some farm veterinary work, the more interesting cases seem to occur in cats and dogs these days! Christmas unfortunately saw the usual list of naughty dogs (and their owners!) which had consumed chocolate. This is the most common form of food toxicity we see around the festive season and is deadly serious, especially if large quantities are consumed or they are high in cocoa content. If we catch them quickly, we can make these patients vomit the chocolate before it becomes absorbed.

This is a good way to cure one's craving for Chocolate Oranges. Once you have enjoyed the sight and delicious smell of these after regurgitation by a dog, you will not be inclined to eat them again!

Many other seasonal foods are amazingly toxic too – most

builders and for DIY tasks, apparently has a sweet taste. This proved too tempting for a Labrador puppy in the town, which was presented to the vets when he started vomiting. The feature of this glue is that it expands to fill a cavity before solidifying, so we had to surgically remove large clumps of the glue from the poor pup's stomach. After a recovery period,

notably raisins, grapes and currants, especially in fruit cakes. Even onions and garlic must not be fed to pets.

Cats are particularly sensitive to poisoning by any of the varieties of lily. All parts of this plant are potentially lethal, so make sure cats cannot come into contact with any lilies. Please take great care to dispose of car radiator antifreeze properly, as this too can be lethal and appealing to pets.

This winter I have noted the emergence of a new hazard, which was successfully dealt with by our vets at the practice. GORILLA GLUE, a common material used by

to normal!

Bladder stones can form in the urine of all species, but Jackie removed this stunning example from a poor dog having difficulty passing urine. It was alone, floating around in the bladder, until it was surgically removed. Lab analysis showed that it was mainly composed of silica, and diet can be used to prevent its recurrence in dogs.

Apparently, dogs which eat



soil, possibly while rooting around for other foods on the ground, are more susceptible. Nature can produce some amazing sights!

When I was a student in London during the 1970s, one of our anatomy lecturers was the late Harry Merlen. He was

a great character who had been one of General Montgomery's Desert Rats during World War II. He was a leading authority on camels! He often spoke about "The Bactrian, or two-humped camel, can inflate its soft palate during the rut!" Said in his immaculate and clipped military English, this used to set us all off into fits of giggles.

The Gift of Matilda



The childhood of author Roald Dhal was one of tragedy and pain. A few weeks after his sister died from appendicitis his father died of pneumonia. To compound this misery his experience of school life was one of abject cruelty; suffering many canings (once because he and his friends were found to have put a dead mouse in jar of sweets at the local shop). His next school Repton was far worse. The location for the 1939 film 'Goodbye Mr. Chips', this was nothing like the film's romantic portrayal; beatings of younger children by older boys and masters were frequent and severe.

Of course, it seems that these trials led Roald to write many of his children's stories from the perspective of the underdog, (just as he often must have felt he was as a boy) and his story Matilda is no exception. Many of Roald's real-life experiences can be found in both

the book and the film, and they pour out equally poignantly into the musical which this spring will be the focus of the Easter Camp held by New Youth Theatre.

Matilda is a gifted child, spurned by her selfish and materialistic mother and father: a wanna-be dancer and a crooked car salesman. Her school life is marred by a headmistress who evidently hates children; Miss Trunchbull, who on one occasion boils with rage when she discovers a newt has been placed in her jug of water; (an obvious reference to the mouse in the sweet shop) and there they go to 'The Chokey' a tiny glory hole armed with inwardfacing spikes driven into its door. Miss Honey is the only teacher who has any sympathy with Matilda. She tries her best to encourage her and advance her education but Miss Trunchbull is having none of it. After suffering many acts of cruelty Matilda's inner fury brims over, displaying an ability to move things with her mind. This effect once used on Miss Trunchbull creates a hilarious ending to the Headmistress' career terrorising her into believing that a ghost is after her. At this point her father, having annoyed the Russian mafia by selling dodgy cars to them, finds his life in peril. However the head of the mafia likes Matilda and lets the matter drop on condition that she goes to live with Miss Honey, which is what she does and a happy ending brings this wonderful show to a satisfying end and great applause, especially since throughout there have been some

great song and dance routines. If you are feeling that you'd like to perform on stage but are a little afraid to make that first step, then perhaps this show is the one to unlock your bravery. Just like Matlida found her inner courage, you too will be inspired by the story to do the same. It's very unlikely that you'll be gifted with the ability to move things with your mind, but you will find the ability to move your life with your inner spirit which this show is bound to release in you. From this point on you'll find you have the courage to do so much more, so that when the real trials of life challenge you, you'll have discovered that you have what it takes to meet them. In any case, you'll have made some great friends along the way, had a great time learning new songs and dance steps and discovered the fun that can be had with simply performing in front of an audience. Your applause when it reaches your ears only helps to let you know that you've grown as a person and been given a gift to last your whole life through; the simple and effective gift of self-confidence.


