## **Grantham Then**

By John Manterfield



As a local historian, I am always struck by the inequality of the distribution of historical sources both over time and geographically. Our Grantham Hall Book the earliest surviving minute book of the Corporation of the Borough of Grantham

- begins in 1633. Five earlier volumes (now lost) covered the period from 1463 when the borough was incorporated. Would it not be wonderful if those detailed volumes of the previous 170 years had survived to shed more light on our Tudor and Stuart town?

As a collector of picture postcards of Grantham, I get a buzz finding different views taken in the town during the late Victorian or Edwardian period. Busy street scenes with shops and houses, horses. carts, delivery wagons and early motor cars are full of interest. Scenes taken in St Peter's Hill, High Street, Watergate, the Market Place and Westgate are the most frequently found for obvious reasons. Conversely, photographs and postcards of Castlegate and Swinegate/Elmer Street seem much rarer, apart, of course, from views around St Wulfram's Church and the Beehive. 'Grantham' - two rarities are thine, a lofty steeple and a living sign' is wording from this famous inn-sign and I am sometimes tempted to add a third category of rarity - photographic images and postcards of the middle parts of both Castlegate and Elmer Street! Perhaps some readers of Grantham Now have a secret stash covering these streets that they would share with us?

The Swinegate photograph was taken prior to the outbreak of the Great War possibly c1910. On the right was Burton's 'Motor & Cycle Works' advertising repairs, oils and storage. Behind is the approach to St Wulfram's Church without the raised and walled flower beds with which we are familiar today. On the left was the Rose and Crown public house which stood next to the Blue Pig. Swinegate lies in the centre of our medieval town. Partly obscured by the lamp standard, the building on the left-hand side, with its then rendered gable end on to the street, is the Tudor half-timbered house. Across the road was another pub. The Crown & Anchor.

St Wulfram's parish church is always well worth a visit. The chained library contains some of the earliest printed books ever produced dating from the late fifteenth century. Recent conservation and cleaning have restored several exceptional Georgian funeral monuments including two by the Westminster sculptor Sir Henry Cheere. His

monument to Grantham's naval hero. Captain William Cust. stands in the south aisle. William was 'unfortunately killed by a cannon-ball' in 1748 whilst serving in the West Indies. His older brother was Sir John Cust, Speaker of the House of Commons, and his mother was Lady Anne Cust of Grantham House.

The area from the High Street, through Vine Street and Swinegate and leading to St Wulfram's Church. contains many listed buildings and lies at the heart of the town's Conservation Area. It is one of the most visited areas in Grantham as tourists and pilgrims make their way to the church which stands proudly in the well-kept green churchyard. Could this approach to the Church be made more inviting and attractive by trimming back the bushes and trees on the right-hand side allowing a clearer view of the lofty steeple? Where is there any convenient disabled parking? What impression is given by the uneven paving flags? From a purely practical point of view, there is nowhere close to the Church for coaches to drop visitors. Neither is there a level access from Castlegate for wheelchair users. The Church community is itself very conscious of the step down at the main west entrance. We have a treasure in the church that is a focal point in the town's visitor economy. I believe the time has come to look afresh at the wider external approach and access arrangements.

## **Back Off Pain!**

those cartoons of postmen running like mad down a garden path as an angry dog sinks its teeth into the fleshy parts of the poor chap's anatomy: strange what used to pass for humour back then, enough to make vou wince just looking at it though, making us imagine just how painful it would be were it not a drawing but happening for real. 



# Focus on... Avenue Veterinary Centre

with Richard Huddart, a veterinary surgeon at the Avenue Veterinary Centre in Grantham and Bottesford.

In this article Richard Huddart, a veterinary surgeon at the Avenue Veterinary Centre in Grantham and Bottesford, describes a couple of common presentations which might need veterinary attention!



Our clients often notice that their pets are "drinking lots more than usual". On further questioning, we might be told that the water bowl seems to require filling more frequently, or that the pet has been seen more at the bowl. A cat might be seen uncharacteristically drinking from puddles or from the tap or toilet. When it comes to quantifying the amount of water a pet is consuming, however, things become trickier. If a cat or dog drinks up to 60mls per kilogram of body weight in a 24-hour period, there is usually nothing to worry about. It may be really difficult to measure this, however, particularly if there is more than one animal in the house, or there are additional sources of drinking water.

The generally accepted figure of 100mls of water per kg bodyweight is the level at which most vets would be especially concerned about kidney disease, diabetes or Cushing's syndrome. This would be around 3 litres for a large Labrador! If there are other symptoms or concerns, your vet would probably advise further investigations and lab tests to confirm the diagnosis and start effective treatment.





Changes in food preference will often be the first clue of mouth and dental problems - dogs may become less keen on chew treats and chewing toys, for instance. Cats may become less interested in dry food, and rabbits may remain happy to eat their pellets and fresh greens but reduce their hay intake - or vice-versa, for that matter! Any change in food preference or chewing behaviour should prompt an examination by the vet, who will be looking initially for any obvious source of dental or oral problems, which may be causing



discomfort or difficulty. In dogs and cats, common causes include periodontal disease caused by plaque accumulation, but damaged teeth, dental abscesses, tongue or other soft tissue injuries, gum disease, and infections or tumours in the mouth can all sometimes be implicated.

In rabbits and rodents, the first sign of dental disease is often a change in eating behaviour, which can sometimes be associated with 'cudding' - allowing half chewed food to fall from the mouth. Rabbit and rodent teeth erupt continuously, which



means that they continue to grow throughout life and depend on continuous wear to counteract this process and prevent them from growing too long. If this wear does not occur normally, which is most often a result of anatomy or improper diet, then the teeth become progressively longer, which interferes with the normal action of the jaw and will eventually prevent the pet from eating normally. This overgrowth can affect not only the incisors – which can be seen in the front of the mouth – but also the back teeth, known collectively as the 'cheek teeth'.

Sadly, it's virtually impossible to fully examine rabbits' and rodents' mouths while they are awake, and often an anaesthetic and sometimes x-rays will be required to allow for a full assessment to take place so that appropriate treatment can be given. Dental problems tend to recur following treatment and repeated procedures are often required once the problems have been established. So careful attention to appropriate diet from early in life is particularly important - talk to your vet for advice if you're unsure.



# Lasting Power of Attorney (LPA)



Emily Lister, an Associate of the Chartered Institute of Legal Executives, explains that a Lasting Power of Attorney (LPA) is a legal document that allows someone to make decisions for you, or act on your behalf if you are no longer able to because of lack of capacity (due to illness, mental health issues, dementia, confusion, drowsiness or unconsciousness). The person appointed becomes known as your 'Attorney' and can legally make decisions on your behalf.

There are two types of LPAs:

**Property & Finance** - which can be used when registered with the donor's permission, even when they have capacity.

**Health & Welfare** – this can only be used when the donor loses capacity and is for Attorney/s to make decisions on general living conditions, medical treatment and, if authorised, end of life decisions.

It is a misconception to assume that if you are married or in a civil partnership that your spouse would be able to deal with your bank account and pensions and make decisions about your healthcare if you lose the ability to do so. This is not the case. Without an LPA a spouse will not have the authority. This could be devastating, especially if the joint owner has their only form of income, such as their pension, paid into this joint account.

Accidents, strokes, brain injuries and Parkinson's disease can also affect someone's ability to make their own decisions. Managing your financial affairs can become virtually impossible. Charities who care for the elderly recommend everyone plans ahead by having at least one LPA which could save a great deal of money and ease the burden on their relatives.

If you lose mental capacity without an LPA in place, it will be necessary for your family to apply to the Court of Protection to have a deputy appointed to deal with everyday financial matters. This is a slow and very expensive process that can cost thousands of pounds. If you have to use a lawyer, it could cost a lot more. However, if you have an LPA in place, this will not be necessary.

You can choose more than one Attorney, but you must decide if they are to make decisions jointly or separately. The role of an Attorney involves a great deal of power and responsibility, so it is vital that you trust the person or people you choose.



Anyone who's keen on a life in show business would do well to delve into the true story of Phineas Taylor Barnum, a man who, with an over-exuberance of American zeal, threw himself wholeheartedly into a host of businesses in the nineteenth century before finding fame and fortune with what became known as 'The Greatest Show'. The musical 'The Greatest Showman' is very loosely based on the real P.T. Barnum; a man brimming with an inspiration for life!

After trying his hand at newspaper publishing, general store ownership and book trading he bought a museum in New York and began showing human curiosities; freak shows they were called by some, displaying a real mermaid (so he said) and the amazingly small 'General Tom Thumb'. His wax figure museum was a 'must see'. He went on to become a town mayor and entered into politics in the dying days of the Whig Party. To say he was quite a character is to make quite an understatement.



Turning this man's life into a musical however takes the kind of showmanship which our friend Phineas here would have been proud of. Never ones to let the facts get in the way of a good story, the writers of the film

version; Jenny Bicks and Bill Condon have created a dazzling, yet seamless robe of a tale, keeping only as close to Barum's real life as entertainment will allow. Truly mesmerising are the songs; fantastically composed by Benj Pasek and Justin Paul; great numbers which swell into highly emotional works to lift the heart or tug at it. The show follows Barnum's fall and fall, then rise and rise; his meeting with Queen Victoria and then discovering the beautifully talented Swedish singer Jenny Lind. She was quite a catch for him, and he reciprocated by paying her an astonishing \$1,000 per show, almost unheard of in the 1800s.

To make this spectacular show work for New Youth Theatre's Summer Camp the search is on to find the perfect Jenny Lind. In fact they also need a larger than life P.T. Barnum (and his younger self for the beginning of the show), a Phillip Carlyle the playwright, a Charity Hallett-Barnum (Phineaes' wife), an acrobat, a bearded lady, a tiny General Tom Thumb (a great role for a small child) and a whole host of weird, wonderful and bizarre nineteenth century curiosities in the chorus line, capable of helping to make 'The Greatest Showman' burst into life. With a rousing title song like 'The Greatest Show', leading into the flashback number 'A Million Dreams', Jenny Lind's rendition of 'Never Enough' and the complete ensemble anthem of 'From Now On', there is musical entertainment aplenty, not just for the audience but for the cast too in performing them. The Summer Camp takes place at The Guildhall in Grantham between 5th and 9th August, then once more at Sleaford's Riverside Church between 19th and 23rd August, in each case from 10 am and 4 pm every day.

However, the show never ends when the Summer Camp is over; far from it. You take with you a week of learning how to pull together as a team, you are able to take inspiration from the life of this colourful man and you will have gathered a greater sense of confidence about yourself. In short, you will have grown as a person. The new you will have more of what it takes to face the world and to make a success out of your life. P.T. Barnum never stopped to think of 'Why?', he was only interested in 'Why not?'. So, as he might have yelled from outside the theatre, 'Roll up, roll up, step right this way, take courage and join me in 'The Greatest Show' of them all'.

## **Vegan Sausage Lasagne**

### Sausage sauce

- 1 medium carrot chopped
- 3 shallots or 1 medium onion chopped
- 200g mushrooms sliced
- 1 packet of Vegan Bratwurst
- 1 tin of chopped tomatoes + 3/4 tin of water
- ½ teaspoon sugar
- Salt/pepper to taste
- 2 teaspoons Oregano
- 1/2 teaspoon celery salt
- 3 tablespoons tomato puree
- Vegetable oil or olive oil for frying
- 1 tablespoon of plain flour
- 2-3 cloves of garlic crushed
- 2 tablespoons chopped parsley
- Fry the bratwurst and remove from the pan. In the same pan fry the carrot, onion and mushrooms until lightly brown, then add the flour and stir in. Fry for a minute.
- Add tomato, water and tomato puree, bring to a simmer.
- Add the rest of the ingredients and sausage and simmer for 10 minutes stirring occasionally.

### **Vegan Cheese Sauce**

- 1½ oz vegan spread or margarine
- 1½ oz plain flour
- 1¼ pint unsweetened soya milk
- 1 teaspoon of whole grain mustard
- ½ packet of GreenVie ParVeggio vegan
- cheese (100G packet) 80g of grated Violife Mozzarella
- Grind of black pepper

### Other ingredients

100% Durum wheat lasagne sheets Original Rice Mozzarella

- Melt the spread and whisk in the plain flour, cook for 1 minute. Slowly add the soya milk over a low heat whisking as you go.
- Add the mustard and pepper and cook for 4-5 minutes




